4) **Minutes Approval** .. 5.25.17

With Doug Botimers/Declarant absence tonight, the Board did not have a voting quorum. Vote on the 5.25.17 Minutes will be delayed until the next Board meeting.

5) Common Area Update

Scott Towlee, VGC Common Area Chair reported that Ray Goff & Donna Fisher have identified [and prioritized] several trees on our north/south walking trails for removal. Scott said most are either diseased or overcrowding other trees; Some of this work can be done with volunteers.

COMMON AREA MAINTENANCE Contractor Ike Muro discovered someone had turned off the well pump and timer during a high temperature week-end .. As of today we have no suspects. Scott reported no major issues with our common area and complemented IKE and his crew. Ike continues to do a great job for us with the many challenges in maintaining our common areas. Scott suggested we consider planning "something" to thank Ike and crew ..

PHASE 9 UPDATE .. We are experiencing a few challenges in Phase 9 mostly concerning irrigation in homeowner backyards areas. Scott learned that Palisch installed a common area drip line for new trees along the east & west property lines is located in some Phase 9 backyards. Scott suggested a meeting be held with Jason Spence, Phase 9 homeowners, and our Master Board to answer questions and welcome Phase 9 to our HOA.

SOUTH of the Creek UPDATE .. Ray Goff has been busy along the creek trail planting new trees and bushes. He has borrowed Ike's equipment to cut back blackberries and remove fire fuel. Also Ray planted pasture grass in those recovered areas. The new plantings have changed the look, made the area safer for walkers & homeowners , and has reduced the fire danger. .

6) ARC & LUS Update .. Michele Wollert reported that continuous homeowner education through LUS violation letters and windshield notices is working and said, now, about 98% of homeowners are in compliance. Also, ARC has sent house repainting notices with a one year time frame to comply; All present praised Michele for her excellent ARC outcomes.

7) Crime Prevention update

Daryl Schriener [and CP Police] confirmed that a date for the orientation/organizational meeting of the Villages Crime Watch Committee is set for Monday 19 June [6 pm] at the Club House @ Lions Park, College Place. This meeting will provide an opportunity to involve all Phases in our crime watch & prevention planning along with recruiting the necessary leadership for this new & important VGVC committee ..
