

Safety/Security Committee Report

PROJECTS

MAY 25, 2020

The Safety/Security Committee had been actively working on several projects before the COVID-19 pandemic. These included:

- Recruitment for representatives from all phases. Currently filled at 50% .
- Designing committee and representative responsibilities.
- Completing inspections of all common and owned properties (from street), for potential hazards. One phase complete.
- Communicating thru emails to residents topics of concern. This included information on thefts of car parts, awareness of safety and self while walking, and bikes/skateboards on paths.

Currently the focus has been entirely on COVID-19 issues and how they impact the safety of residents. Thru emails, mailbox flyers and signage, social distancing reminders have been communicated. COVID-19 has brought into the Village additional traffic of non-residents, causing concern for safety of residents using our outdoor spaces. Enormous increases of bicycles, scooters, and skateboards on the sidewalks and paths have prompted the use of signage to discourage this activity as it compromises the safety of residents using the walkways. We expect that social distancing will continue to be encouraged, and will continue with communications for such.

Future plans include:

- Inspection of all street lighting to ensure working order.
- Continue inspection of all phases
- Continue recruitment for representatives.
- Communicate events as they occur and as needed.

Our committee co-chairs have met numerous times to work on these topics and will continue to do so again when the situation allows.
