2023 NOMINATION and ELECTION of DIRECTORS

The business of the VGC is managed by a Board of seven directors elected by association members at the Annual Meeting as specified in the By-laws.

Nomination Options

- 1. Advance Nominations by the current Board of Directors or an ad hoc Nomination Committee**
- 2. Advance Nomination by a member or group of members within the specified open nomination time period (October 24 through November 17,2023) by email to info@villagesofgarrisoncreek.com including the name(s) of member(s) submitting the nominee for candidacy consideration.**
- 3. Advance Nomination by an individual member who wishes to submit their own name for nomination.**
- 4. Annual meeting nominations from the floor during the designated agenda time. Floor nominees are encouraged to be present to accept nominations and shall have the opportunity to present a 2 to 3 minute written or verbal statement comparable to nominee recommendations below.**

Nominee Recommendations

Provide in a single email to info@villagesofgarrisoncreek.com by the announced deadline the following information:

- 1. Name, mailing address, email address, and phone number of the nominee.**
- 2. A brief written statement by the nominee (300 words maximum) including the following:**
 - A. If a member, how long the nominee has been a MPMA member and if a VGC resident, how long.**
 - B. Why the nominee wishes to be considered for service as a director.**
 - C. The nominee's vision for the VGC.**
 - D. Leadership and/or volunteer service in this or another HOA.**
- 3. A JPEG file of a medium-resolution head shot photograph of the nominee shall be attached to the nomination email.**

Nominations will be posted to the website upon receipt with pictures. A printed list of candidates and their bios will be available at the Annual Meeting on December 10.

Ballot Distribution and Voting

- 1. The names of advance nominees will be placed on the official ballot distributed at the annual meeting.**
- 2. Space on the ballot for write-in candidates will be provided.**

- 3. The seven nominees with highest number of votes will be announced after votes are tallied by non-nominee members designated by the Board or its designee.**
