

Safety/Security Annual Meeting Report to Homeowners 2023

- Every year, the committee make a walk thru the Village streets and trails, looking for areas that may pose a hazard to residents. That walk was completed in March, with no large issues noted.
- The completion of the bridge over the west pond stream has been completed. This was noted in 2022 by the safety committee. We are confident this bridge will provide years of safe usage.
- The removal of shrubs and limbs along trail one from the Gazebo now provides better visibility crossing Garrison Village Way and Creekside Dr. for both pedestrians and drivers.
- Pedestrian crossing lines were repainted in the summer. This is the third
 year the committee has painted these. We recognize that some residents
 do not like these, feeling it takes away from the look. We do believe that it
 provides a level of safety and road awareness to pedestrians that they did
 not have before.
- A water drain depression at the intersection of Quail Run and Creekside was addressed after a pedestrian fell after stepping into it. This was refitted to align with the level of the street.
